Pre-K

Pre-K provides an inspiring introduction to Classical Education for little minds. We gently introduce phonics and math as we prepare our students for Kindergarten. Classic works of art and stories are interwoven into weekly lessons and help develop a sense of wonder in our younger students. In Pre-K, we use creative movement, games, stories, poetry, songs and crafts to provide a classical education foundation for our youngest students. Additionally, our students are introduced to a few Latin phrases to pique their interest in the language.

Pre-K students learn classroom expectations and behavior through play and fun. Biblical values, prayer, service, compassion and obedience are taught through interactive stories and questions. Students are encouraged to build habits of respect, listening, following directions and responsibility through methods that respect their innate wonder and desire for self-discovery.
